## Checklist for Submitting a Video

Did you:	
	limit the video to 90 seconds (with no more than an additional 60 seconds for credits)?
	verify that there were no factual or conceptual errors?
	use any images, songs, or sound effects you found online, and if so, are they from the sites specified in the rules?
	add credits at the end, even if the video is only footage you took?
	get release forms signed for anyone identifiable in the video, and file them where you can get them easily if needed?
	check to make sure the file is no larger than 40MB?
	check to make sure the file format is acceptable (.wmv, .avi, m4v, .mov, .mp4)?
	name the file according to the rules?
	send your entry to videos@nextvista.org?
	fill out the online entry form?
	(students:) get your teacher to do the verification form?
	do all of this by the deadline?
